- 12-16 14. Sixth Commandment--You shall not commit adultery.
- 12-20 15. Meaning--We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife should love and honor each other.

1-10 16. Seventh Commandment—You shall not steal.

1-13 17. Meaning—We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way-- but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

1-17 18. Eighth--You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

1-20 19. Meaning—We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation—but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

1-24 20. Ninth Commandment—You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

1-27 21. Meaning—We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way that only appears right--but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

1-31 22. Tenth—You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

2-3 23. Meaning—We should fear & love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him—but urge them to stay and do their duty.

- 3-23 **36. Introduction**—Our Father who art in Heaven.  
*Meaning*—With these words, God tenderly invites us to believe that He is our true Father and we are His true children—so that with all boldness and confidence, we may ask Him as dear children ask their dear father.
- 3-27 **37.** Let us approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need. **Hebrews 4:16**
- 3-30 **38. First Petition**—Hallowed be Thy name.  
*Meaning*—God's name is certainly holy in itself, but we pray in this petition that it may be kept holy among us also.
- \* 4-10 **39. Second Petition**—Thy kingdom come.  
*Meaning*—The kingdom of God certainly comes by itself without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may come to us also.
- 4-13 **40.** The time has come," He said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the Good News!" **Mark 1:15**
- 4-17 **41. Third Petition**—Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven.  
*Meaning*—The good and gracious will of God is done even without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may be done among us also.
- 4-20 **42.** God wants all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth. **1 Timothy 2:4**
- 4-24 **43. Fourth Petition**—Give us this day our daily bread.  
*Meaning*—God certainly gives daily bread to everyone without our prayers, even to all evil people, but we pray in this petition that God would lead us to realize this and to receive our daily bread with thanksgiving.
- 4-27 **44.** The eyes of all look to You, and You give them their food at the proper time. You open Your hand and satisfy the desires of every living thing. **Psalms 145:15 & 16**
- 5-4 **45. Fifth Petition**—And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
*Meaning*—We pray in this petition that our Father in Heaven would not look at our sins or deny our prayers because of them. We are neither worthy of the things for which we pray, nor have we deserved them. But we ask that He would give them all to us by grace, for we daily sin much and deserve nothing but punishment. So we too should sincerely forgive and gladly do good to those who Sin against us.
- 5-8 **46.** Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ, God forgave you. **Ephesians 4:32**

5-15 **47. Sixth Petition**—And lead us not into temptation.

*Meaning*—God tempts no one. We pray in this petition that God would guard and keep us so that the devil, the world, and our sinful nature may not deceive us or mislead us into false belief, despair, or other great shame or vice. Although we are attacked by these things, we pray that we may finally overcome them and win the victory.

5-18 **48.** Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. **Ephesians 6:11**

5-22 **49.** Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Resist him, standing firm in faith. **1 Peter 5:8 & 9**

5-29 **50. Seventh Petition**—But deliver us from evil.

*Meaning*—We pray in this petition that our Father in Heaven would rescue us from every evil of body and soul, possessions and reputation and finally, when our last hour comes, give us a blessed end. That He would graciously take us from this valley of sorrow to Himself in Heaven.

\* 5-31 **51.** The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom. **2 Timothy 4:18**
