FIRST QUARTER

- Dec. 6: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.
- Dec. 9: Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Matthew 28:19
- Dec. 13: Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord. Colossians 3:20
- Dec. 16: Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord. Luke 2:11
- Jan. 3: 5th Commandment: You shall not murder.
- Jan. 6: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.
- Jan. 10: 6th Commandment: You shall not commit adultery.
- Jan. 13: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

Jan. 20: Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Philippians 4:4-5

THIRD QUARTER

- Jan. 31: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.
- Feb. 3: Do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased. Hebrews 13:16
- Feb. 7: 8th Commandment: You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
- Feb. 10: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
- Feb. 14: Love always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 1 Corinthians 13:7
- Feb. 17: No memory

- Feb. 24: 9th Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

Feb. 28: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

Mar. 3: 10th Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

Mar. 7: What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

[Students may say the next memory, the Lord's Prayer, in larger sections or say the whole prayer to get a few days off of memory. **But each part must be said by the date it is scheduled, not later.**]

Mar. 10: The Lord's Prayer: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Mar. 14: Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Mar. 17: And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Mar. 21: For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
